SAS is offering several training options to assist schools in meeting the requirements of the Dignity for All Students Act and ensuring a safe, supportive environment free from bullying, harassment, and discrimination for all students.

1. Dignity Act Coordinator Training

A six hour workshop for newly appointed Dignity Act Coordinators. Participants will learn best practices in prevention and intervention strategies.

2. Dignity Act Update

A two hour workshop for Dignity Act Coordinators, school administrators, and key staff who directly address the issues of bullying, harassment, and discrimination. An update of the amendments to the Dignity Act will be provided.

3. Staff presentation

A one hour workshop for school staff to provide an overview of the Dignity for All Students Act and their role in creating a positive school climate.

4. New Certification Requirement

A six hour training on the social patterns of harassment, bullying and discrimination required of school professionals applying for a certificate or license.

Training can be held at your school or at SAS and tailored to your school's specific needs.
